Beginner classes	Combination of horse and rider to have never won a ODE at any level, otherwise as per for novice classes
Novice classes	Combination of horse and rider not to have won any ODE competition (other than a beginners) and not to have completed a Riding Club or Pony Club open horse trials or any BE horse trials, including BE80(T) .
Open Novice classes	Are for horse and rider combinations who are unable to meet the above restriction but do not want to compete at the Intermediate height.
Junior	To be 8 years old and over & not to have attained their 18th birthday by 31.12.23
Senior	To be 18 years and over on 01.01.24

DFRC ODE INFORMATION & RULES

Course Walking	Both the Cross country & show jumping courses will be open for walking from 2pm on Saturday 7 th Sept 2024.
Dressage	Callers & whips ARE allowed as per BRC rules
Numbers & Bibs	Please bring your own bib & please print your own numbers. Numbers & bib template will be available on www.ridingclubresults.co.uk . Bibs can be bought from the secretary for £10 in cash.
Cancellation & Abandonment	Should the event be cancelled, a £15 abandonment fee will be retained
Refunds	Refunds will not be made for withdrawals after the closing date unless the space can be filled in which case a £10 admin fee will be retained. Withdrawals made before the closing date will be subject to a £5 admin fee.
Flu Vaccination Policy	All horses competing must be fully vaccinated and had their last booster within 12 months of the event, but not in the preceding 7 days. <u>Spot checks will be undertaken.</u>
Stallions	Stallions are not allowed at any DFRC event
Dogs	All dogs to be on lead - £10 recovery fee for those found wandering.
Hats	As per current BRC 2024 handbook standards. 'Protective Headwear' must be worn at all times by anyone, whether or not a competitor, riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted & fastened. <u>For Cross country: Only a "Jockey Skull" of an even round or elliptical shape with a smooth or slightly abrasive surface, with no fixed peak or peak type extension. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used.</u>
Headcams	The use of HEAD CAMS are strictly prohibited at any BRC affiliated competition. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.
Body Protectors & Air Jackets	As per current BRC 2024 handbook standards: A BETA Blue 2018 Level 3 body protector is compulsory for Cross Country. Air Jackets are permitted over an approved body protector.
Photography	Please be advised that photography will be taking place at this event. If you do not wish to appear in any images captured please inform the secretary. The photographs/film could potentially be published on DFRC website & social media, and/or BRC promotional material in future.
SJ Elimination	Competitors eliminated in the show jumping, other than for error of course, will not be allowed to start on the cross-country phase.
Smallwood EC Event Directions	Leave the M6 at junction 17 taking the A534 towards Congleton. Carry straight on over the traffic lights. Approximately 1 mile further along the Congleton Road, turn right into Brookhouse Lane and follow this road for a further mile. Smallwood is on this road. DFRC Signs will be positioned on route.
